

Cave Lake Pet Policy

Cave Lake appreciates the fact that many campers like to travel with and share their camping experience with the family pet. However, to help insure the safety and enjoyment of all guests of Cave Lake you must read and abide by our pet policy as outlined below. Failure to do so may result in you being asked to leave the park.

- Pets of any breed showing aggressive behavior are not welcome. Any pet that is noisy, dangerous, intimidating, or destructive will not be allowed to remain in the campground.
- Pet waste must be picked up (no matter where they relieve themselves in the campground) and properly disposed of in trash receptacles.
- Pets are to be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times. A leash is required (preferably 6' or less in length) whenever the animal is outside your camping unit (tent, camper, RV, etc) – this includes early morning or during the night.
- No pet should be left tied up and unattended outside the owner's camping unit. Pets are not to be tied to trees, shrubs, water hydrants, electric drops, picnic tables, shelter facilities, etc.
- Allowing your pet to bark uncontrollably day or night will not be permitted.
- Pets are not permitted in any buildings or within the fenced beach/swimming area. This includes shower/restroom areas, laundry area, cabins, shelter houses, office/store.
- Pets must be vaccinated against rabies.
- Pets must be confined in the owner's camping unit during quiet hours (11 pm – 8 am).
- Pet owners will be held responsible for the actions of their pets and will pay for any and all damages to property, buildings, etc. caused by their pets.
- Any structure for confining pets outside your camping unit must be collapsible so it can be removed when you are not camping at your site.

- The Pike County Health Department is requiring effective January 1, 2010, that your pet(s) is a **registered guest(s)** with us also. Each pet only has to be registered once a year but each pet has to be registered that will be on Cave Lake property. This information must be kept on file at the Cave Lake office. You may mail the information into to us or bring it with you.
