Cave Lake Campground Rules

Thank you for following our camp
rules. They were chosen to help
ensure everyone's stay is safe and
pleasant. Anyone creating a
disturbance or violating the rules will
be asked to leave without a refund.

With the exception of hikers passing through Cave Lake property on the Buckeye Trail and Cave Lake season/monthly campers, all persons who wish to enter the property must **check in with the office**, show identification, leave their names, addresses, and phone numbers, get permission to use the property for a specific reason, and check out with the office before they leave.

Quiet Time is 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Children must be at their campsite during these hours. No conduct is permitted which interferes with the enjoyment or use of the property by paid guests and Ohio-West Virginia YMCA program participants. No unlawful conduct is permitted on the property.

ONE vehicle per site. Extra vehicle must park in the parking lot by the showerhouse or in the extra parking area near the beach house. Do NOT park on adjacent sites.

Golf Cart Usage

Golf carts must be registered with the office and **only** individuals with a **driver license** are to operate the carts on the property.

For everyone's safety, the **speed limit** within the park is 10 mph. **No motorcycles, mini-bikes, 4-wheelers, 3-wheelers, ATVs, dirt bikes, go carts, snowmobiles** may be ridden in the park. Motorcycles are allowed for transportation to campsites only. No vehicles of any kind are permitted on the property except on the paved drives and parking areas of the campground and at the camper sites.

All **campfires** must be under control and attended at all times. Fires are permitted in fire rings only, and rings are not to be moved. All fires must be extinguished when leaving the campsite or retiring for the evening. Please no trash, cans, or glass in fire rings.

No fauna, flora, plants, or animals may be picked, damaged, injured, destroyed, trapped, captured, killed, or removed on or from the property except in connection with lawful fishing or hunting, when the office has given express permission for such fishing or hunting, and except in connection with lawful gathering of berries or mushrooms, when the office has given express permission for such gathering. The use of such berries or mushrooms is at the picker's risk. The Ohio-West Virginia YMCA does not guarantee the safety or health effects of eating or using any berries or mushrooms picked on its property.

No **swimming** is permitted except for paid guests or participants in Ohio-West Virginia YMCA sponsored programs. Swimming is without lifeguards and is at the swimmer's own risk. No child under 16 years of age may swim without adult supervision. Swimming must be confined to the fenced area directly off the beach and defined by the floating buoys and rope.

No **boating** is permitted on the lake except for paid guests or participants in Ohio-West Virginia YMCA sponsored programs.

No **fishing** is permitted except for paid guests or participants in Ohio-West Virginia YMCA sponsored programs.

We assume no responsibility for **loss** by fire, theft, or accident. Use of facilities is at your own risk.

Pets are allowed, but the pet owner must abide by our Pet Policy (posted at the office and on our web site). Pets must be registered with office.

No firearms or other deadly weapons are permitted on the property except for firearms used for the express purpose of lawful hunting when the office has given express permission for such hunting.

No one may possess alcohol or illegal drugs while on the property, provided however, that while not encouraged, persons paying for camper locations may use alcohol at those locations so long as they do not break state laws (underage drinking, etc.) and so long as they do not create a nuisance for others on the property. **Alcohol should be placed in a solo cup or in some way kept at a low-profile.**

No **smoking** is permitted in Ohio-West Virginia buildings (restrooms, showers, office, rental units, Lakefront Room, Beach House, etc).

Use of **Shelter Houses** is by reservation only. There is a fee for their use and they are not to be used unless they have been reserved and fee paid.

Season/monthly campers must acquire an **entrance gate control** with a \$20 deposit and are responsible for allowing all of their guests entry and exit through the controlled gate and are responsible for the conduct of their children and guests.

Campsite must be kept **clean and tidy**. No refrigerators or other appliances to be kept outside of trailer. No clotheslines permitted at campsites. **No roofs** can be built over trailers or as extensions to trailers; but decks may be built after camp management approval. A \$50 deck deposit is required, refundable when camper properly removes and disposes of deck. **No storage buildings** or pallets allowed on campsite.

Monthly fee payments are due at the office by the **10th of each month**. **Late monthly payments** are assessed a \$10 late charge for each month late. If in arrears by one month, your camping privileges are suspended until payment is received. If in arrears by two months, your camper will be removed from its site (\$50 removal fee and you are charged a storage fee). After three months in arrears, we will dispose of the camper and your camping privileges are permanently terminated. All monthly fees must be paid for a campsite before that camping unit can be removed from the park or advertised for sale by camp management.

Be aware that **power outages** do occur and any spoilage of food left in refrigerators during any such outage is the responsibility of the camper, not camp management.

Season boat permits must be purchased at the office by May 15th and displayed on boat, or boat will be locked in storage.
