The Vitals

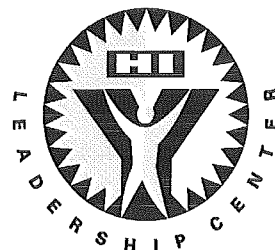
- ARRIVE:** Friday, November 18, 2011 – 4:00 p.m. – Registration begins. Be here no earlier than 4:00 p.m. and no later than 5:00 p.m.
- DEPART:** Sunday, November 20, 2011 – after the final session at noon.
(*Everyone is expected for the total program – don't come late or leave early.*)
- BRING:** Only what is needed. Warm casual clothes, jacket, bath towel, wash cloth, soap, toothbrush and paste, sleeping bag (if desired) **bed linens and pillows are furnished.**
- DON'T BRING:** Radios, CD players, cell phones, expensive jewelry or watches, etc..., illegal drugs or alcohol, weapons, etc. See Code of Conduct.

Program Materials To Bring

- 1. Registration Form** – every participant (including adults) is required to submit a registration form. Student form must include the medical release and code of conduct complete **with parent or guardian signature**. It is now all on one form.
- 2. Banners**, posters, pictures, display of a special program or project, etc. that *Tell Your HI-Y Story*. We'll have table and wall space for displays – let us know what's needed.
- 3. Budget** – copy of your HI-Y's budget for the year.
- 4. HI-Y's Masterpiece Theater** – have an act your HI-Y can present, members with serious talent to share, etc. Turn in a Masterpiece Theater form for each act at registration or no later than 7:00 p.m. Saturday night. We'll take them on a first turned in, first accepted basis as long as they can fit into the available time. Your form must include advisor signature approving your skit or talent.
- 5. Extra money** for the "HI-Y Store" and "HI-Y Pizza Party".
Pizza information is enclosed.

Registration at Jackson's Mill

Delegation Leaders only register their total group with Y Staff in the Harrison Cottage between 4:00 – 5:00 p.m. Leader gives a list of any changes in their group's participation to the staff at registration.

Make it Safe for Everyone

Think *Safety First!* Review with the total delegation before leaving for Fall Conference the Code of Conduct, other rules related to the conference site and those of your own school and HI-Y. Promote common sense. . . Ask everyone to put themselves in others' shoes – parents, HI-Y advisors, the HI-Y Leadership Center, their school, their HI-Y's purpose. Have a discussion on what it takes for everyone to have a fun *and safe* weekend. *Then, everyone hold everyone in the group to responsibility!*

Group Pictures

We'll take group picture on Saturday for a news release to your paper. *Let's get some good PR out of this . . . wear HI-Y, YG, UN, etc. t-shirts*, not shirts advertising something else.

Jackson's Mill:

Housing

HI-Y staff assign all participants to specific housing. Be there, sleep there. Security requires knowing who is in what building and room.

Cabins

Once in the assigned cabin, check its condition. Delegations are financially responsible for the building they are assigned. Anything wrong at check in, tell Y Staff – best to put it in writing.

Do not move beds. Jackson's Mill charges extra for each bed moved. We'll bill your HI-Y.

Keep outside doors and windows closed and thermostats set no higher than 68.

Meals

Remain standing for announcements and grace.

Check Out

Before leaving for home on Sunday, clean your cabin sleeping rooms, restrooms, lobbies, and grounds around the building. Then, Delegation Leaders get a Y Staff to go with you to inspect the cabin. We don't want Jackson's Mill to charge us for extra cleaning or repairs to damage that we did not cause.

Cancellations/ Refunds

Our policy is **NOT TO PROVIDE REFUNDS**. The Center **does** permit sending a replacement for the person who must cancel.

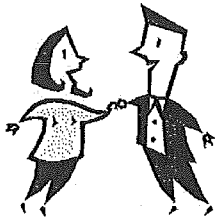

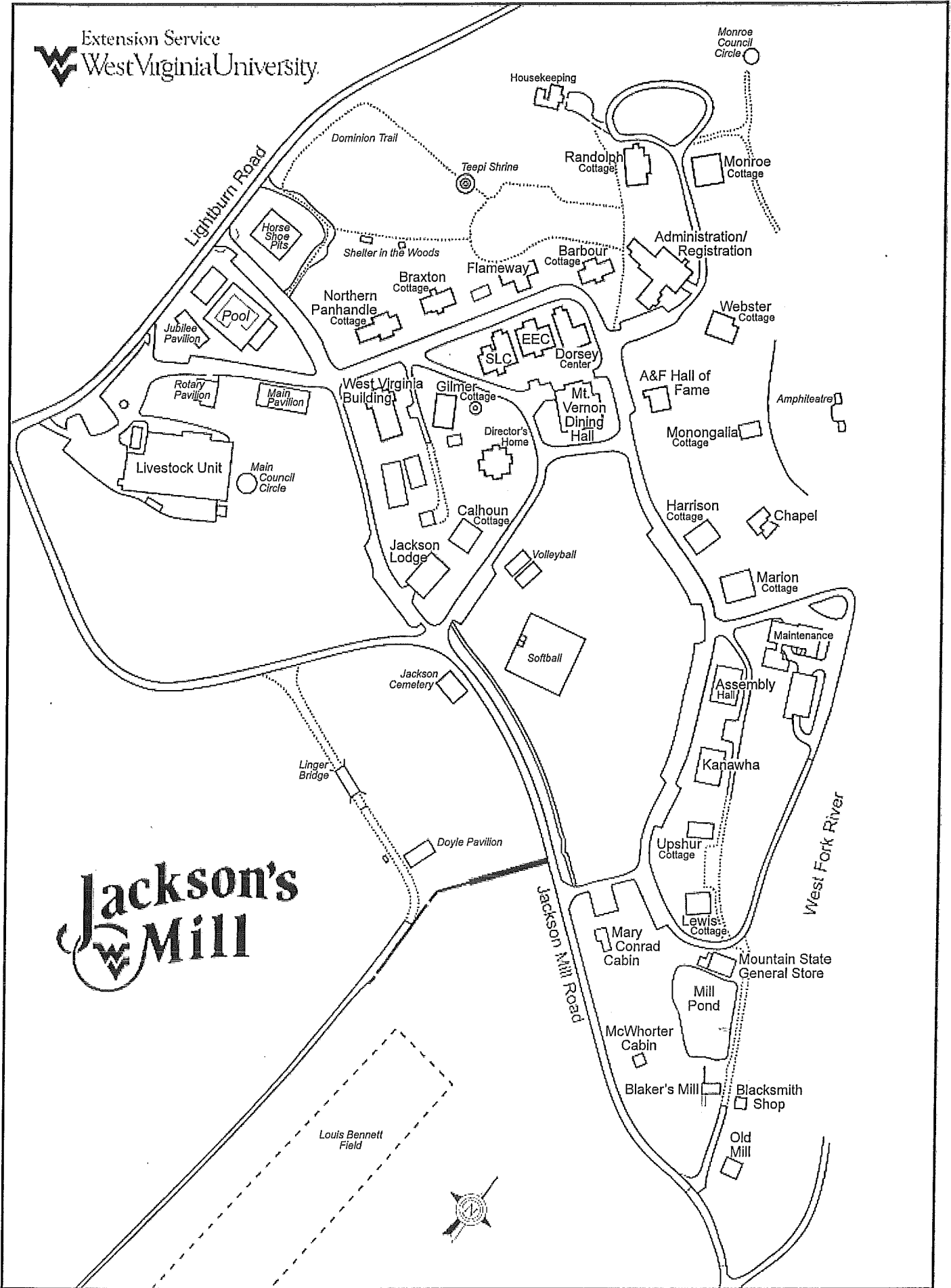
Places to socialize – Our assigned meeting rooms are for everyone to socialize. No coed visitation in cabins or cabin lobbies.

Traveling South on I-79

Taking Exit 105, turn right toward Jane Lew, and travel approximately 1/2 mile to the intersection of Route 19. Turn left and follow Route 19 South for approximately 7 miles to Jackson's Mill Road. (The Hickory House Restaurant is a landmark.) Turn right onto Jackson's Mill Road and go approximately 2.5 miles. After you cross the bridge, the WVU Jackson's Mill grounds are on your right.

Traveling North on I-79

Using Exit 99, turn left toward Weston onto Route 33 West and travel approximately 2 miles. At the fourth traffic light, turn right onto Route 19 North. Follow Route 19 North for approximately 4 miles to Jackson's Mill Road. (The Hickory House Restaurant is a landmark.) Turn left onto Jackson's Mill Road and travel approximately 2.5 miles. After you cross the bridge, the WVU Jackson's Mill grounds are on your right.

Traveling West on Route 33

Continue straight on Route 33 through the Interstate 79 interchange. At the fourth traffic light (approximately 2 miles), turn right onto Route 19 North. Follow Route 19 North for approximately 4 miles to Jackson's Mill Road. (The Hickory House Restaurant is a landmark.) Turn left onto Jackson's Mill Road and travel approximately 2.5 miles. After you cross the bridge, the WVU Jackson's Mill grounds are on your right.

Traveling East on Route 33

Take Route 33 into Weston, then follow signs for Route 19 North. After approximately 4 miles, (the Hickory House Restaurant is a landmark), turn left onto Jackson's Mill Road and travel approximately 2.5 miles. After you cross the bridge, the WVU Jackson's Mill grounds are on your right.

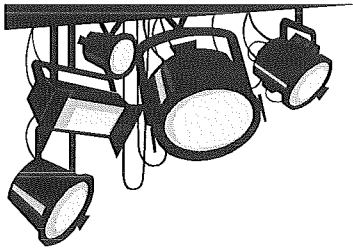

WVU JACKSON'S MILL COTTAGE RULES & PROCEDURES

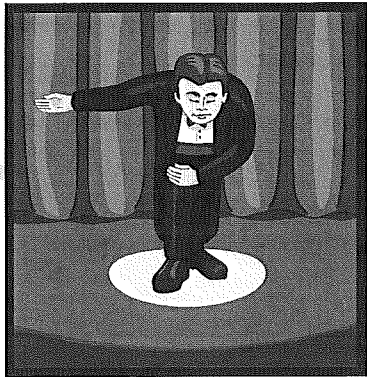
The following information is listed as a reminder for all overnight guests. We hope you have a very enjoyable stay!

- ✓ Please **do not write on the window blinds**. Although this has been a cottage tradition in the past, it is no longer permitted. The new window blinds were made and installed for your convenience. Any damages or writing will result in a significant charge to your group. All cottages will be inspected by Jackson's Mill staff before your group arrives & after your group leaves.
- ✓ Please **do not leave money or valuables** in your room or cottage. Jackson's Mill cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. For your convenience, we will be happy to provide safekeeping for your valuables in the Registration Office.
- ✓ So that we may serve you better, please report any housekeeping or maintenance problems to the Registration Office.
- ✓ **Do not** rearrange the furniture. If Jackson's Mill staff has to move furniture to it's original locations after your group leaves, there will be additional charges.
- ✓ No smoking, cooking or pets are allowed.
- ✓ **At checkout**, (11am), please remove both sheets and the pillow case and place them in the middle of the bed.
- ✓ Fold the blanket(s) and place it at the foot of the bed. Place the pillow at the top of the bed.
- ✓ Please **do not remove** blankets, pillows, sheets, etc. from the cottages, all missing or damaged items will be a significant charge to your group.

Variety Show



Good Taste – Acts are performed in front of a large, diverse group of people. Acts that infer crude, sexual, racial, drug-related, or bigoted points of view are NOT in good taste, and are NOT welcome in the show. Things that “put down” states, ethnic, or gender groups, etc are to be avoided. Pretend that your mother and minister are in the audience. When in doubt, leave it out.

Length– Acts should not exceed more than 5

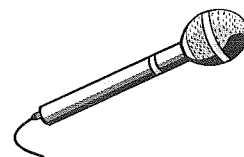
Variety – What’s a Variety Show without it?? Think of funny skits, as well as serious songs; upbeat acts as well as monologues with a message. Try camp pieces, group songs, one-liners, and so on. Use your imagination and have fun. **Sorry, no lip-synching.**

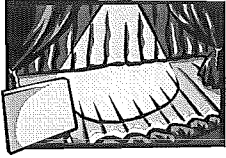
Projection – The Variety Show will be held in a big room, so acts should be able to be heard well!
