1. Develop a written constitution.
2. Have an adult advisor.
3. Achieve YMCA minimum standards for HI-Ys and comply with any school standards.
4. Affiliate with the HI-Y Leadership Center. Through affiliation, members and HI-Ys join the Center and together develop a strong HI-Y movement. HI-Ys help financially support the Center's HI-Y program through annual dues of \$10.00 per member and \$10.00 per HI-Y.

SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE HI-Y LEADERSHIP CENTER

1. Professional YMCA staff who maintain a continuing relationship with your HI-Y.
2. HI-Y materials, officer information, program ideas, etc.
3. Regular newsletters sent to all officers to provide updates on HI-Y programs, projects, events, etc.
4. HI-Y Standards and Honor recognition to encourage and recognize high standards.
5. HI-Y Council to represent HI-Ys and members, and improve HI-Y, and help set policy.
6. HI-Y Week to "showcase" HI-Y.
7. Leadership development and citizenship education camps and conferences: Youth in Government, YMCA Camp Horseshoe, Cave Lake, HI-Y Fall Conference, and Model United Nations.
