Advisory Committee Job Description

HI-Y Advisory Committees give HI-Ys help and support from adults and local organizations.

Your Advisory Committee . . .

- Helps interpret your HI-Y to the community,
- Helps your HI-Y secure financing for HI-Y projects and activities,
- Maintains positive relationships with the school and the HI-Y Leadership Center,
- Supports HI-Y activities, conference attendance, projects, and programs by their attendance, serve as chaperones, transportation, and assistance,
- Offers personal guidance to members as well as the HI-Y,
- Provides support to the Advisor,
- Helps develop and implement major policies of the HI-Y,
- Serves for one year (may be re-elected).

An Advisory Committee is selected from parents, business, professional, ministerial, civic organizations, and educational groups in your community.

Another approach is to work with your local Y-Gradale Chapter. Y-Gradale is an adult woman's YMCA service organization. The HI-Y Leadership Center can help your HI-Y establish a Y-Gradale in your community.
